

Calton Primary achieves the GOLD Games Mark Award



We are delighted to announce that we, Calton Primary School, have achieved the School Games Gold Mark Award for the 2017/18 academic year.

The School Games Mark is a Government led award scheme launched in 2012, facilitated by the Youth Sport Trust to reward schools for their commitment to the development of competition across their school and into the community, and we are delighted to have been recognised for our success.

Our sporting achievements this year include:

- Provide two hours of Physical Education each week.
- 52%, 155 children in KS2 attended a sport after school club.
- All children (100%) have taken part in an intra-house competition.
- Run A, B and C teams for boys football.
- Run A and B teams for girls football, netball and rugby.
- Competed against other schools in 9 different sports.
- Developed links with the local community.

With a total of 110 young people competing in local inter-school competitions this year, we are extremely proud of our pupils for their dedication to all aspects of school sport, including those young volunteers, leaders and officials who made our competitions possible.

As part of our application, we were asked to fulfil criteria in the areas of participation, competition, workforce and clubs, and we are pleased that the hard work of everyone at our school has been rewarded this year.
