

Message from Head Teacher

This week in assembly I brought in something which is very special for me (ask your child if they are in Year 1 -6 what it was!).

I continued my focus on how important it is for us all to get enough sleep so that we can enjoy our hours when we are awake. Children across the school were able to identify the reasons we need sleep - to rest, to give us energy and to help our bodies get better (including when we are poorly) and to get us ready for and remember our learning.

I reminded the children how much sleep they are recommended to have broadly based on their ages. In Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 it is around 11 - 12 hours per night whilst in Years

3 - 6 there is a recommendation of between 10 - 11 hours at least.

During the week it has been a pleasure to have children telling me how much sleep they have had and the routines they have before bed. The message is very clear - sleep is important (and for grown ups too!).

Head bump update

The Behaviour Safety and Welfare Committee met on Monday 25th September and discussed head bumps and head bump notifications. It was agreed at this meeting that a generic text to be sent to parents within one hour of a head incident occurring, followed by a slip being sent home at the end of the day.

Please note these are for injuries which are classed as minor or not leaving a mark e.g. children bumping heads. Of course if it is a serious head bump then you will be notified immediately.

Please can we ask that you check book bags particularly if you do not pick your child up at the end of the day.
