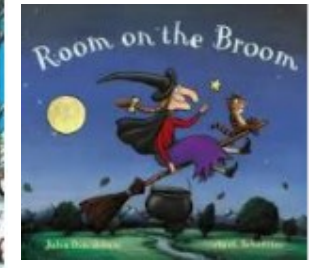
Autumn Term 2 2022

Communication and Language / Literacy

- Listen to simple traditional and new stories and understand what is happening with the help of pictures
- Children joining in with repeated refrains from familiar books
- Words left out of a rhyming sentence for children to fill in
- Vocabulary from stories including Julia Donaldson books

Phonics

- Learning new rhymes and predicting rhyme in well-known books
- Highlighting alliteration in books
- Nursery rhymes



Expressive Arts and Design

- Exploring paint by colour mixing, changing textures and using different tools and techniques
- Listening to music whilst mark making, and playing
- Singing a range of songs
- Beat Baby
- Christmas activities including gingerbread men

Physical

- Developing self-care skills; children put on their coat, shoes, use a toilet and cutlery
- Practise on bikes and scooters
- Dough disco - manipulating playdough to music
- Use a range of resources such as paint, playdough, sand and water to explore a range of tools and techniques

- Learn about different festivals celebrated Diwali, Christmas
- Bonfire Night - Firework Pictures
- Remembrance Day - poppy making
- Changing Seasons Autumn—Winter

Personal, Social, Emotional

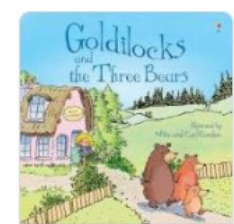
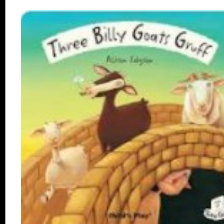
Development
